Title: American Sign Language (ASL) Interpreter

SUMMARY

Sunflower Hill is a non-profit focused on creating spaces and places where adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) thrive. Sunflower Hill at Irby Ranch, located in Pleasanton, is our first affordable, independent living community for adults with developmental disabilities. The organization is growing quickly and it's an exciting time to get involved!

Sunflower Hill is looking for a volunteer with American Sign Language (ASL) knowledge who can help with interpretation services for deaf/hard of hearing residents and/or program participants.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

- Provide a full range of interpreting/transliterating services for deaf/hard of hearing residents
- and/or program participants.
- Hearing interpreters: effectively interpret between ASL and spoken English.
- Deaf interpreters: effectively interpret between ASL, Tactile American Sign Language, other
- forms of visual communication, and written English.
- Provide excellent customer service while maintaining a respectful and professional attitude with residents/participants and staff/colleagues.
- Educate staff on Deaf Culture and interpreting services.

SCHEDULE

Requested volunteer hours will vary by need. Possible volunteer slots could be during activities Monday – Friday 3:00 – 7:30 p.m. and weekends 9 a.m. – 6 p.m. Exact time and day will depend on scheduled activities. Activity schedules are listed two weeks in advance. May also request ASL support during pre-scheduled 1:1 meetings with residents.

QUALIFICATIONS

Display a wide knowledge of language skills in ASL and English.

Licensure and Other Requirements

Ability to pass background check. Background checks are \$42 and paid by the volunteer.
