#### SUMMARY:

Sunflower Hill is a non-profit focused on creating spaces and places where adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (I/DD) thrive. Sunflower Hill at Irby Ranch is the organization's first affordable, independent living community for adults with developmental disabilities. Sunflower Hill also provides in-person and virtual life skills and enrichment programs at both Irby Ranch and the Sunflower Hill Garden, located in Livermore, CA. The organization is growing quickly and it's an exciting time to get involved!

Sunflower Hill is looking for a volunteer with American Sign Language (ASL) knowledge who can help with interpretation services for deaf/hard of hearing residents and/or program participants.

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

The essential functions listed below are general examples and not a description of comprehensive volunteer duties being requested.

- Provide a full range of interpreting/transliterating services for deaf/hard of hearing residents and/or program participants.
- Hearing interpreters: effectively interpret between ASL and spoken English.
- Deaf interpreters: effectively interpret between ASL, Tactile American Sign Language, other forms of visual communication, and written English.
- Provide excellent customer service while maintaining a respectful and professional attitude with residents/participants and staff/colleagues.
- Educate staff on Deaf Culture and interpreting services.

#### **SCHEDULE**

Requested volunteer hours will vary by need. Possible volunteer slots could be Monday – Friday 10:00 AM – 7:00 PM and weekends 11:00 AM – 8:00 PM. Exact time and day will depend on scheduled activities. Activity schedules are listed one month in advance. May also request ASL support during pre-scheduled 1:1 meeting with residents.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

Display a wide knowledge of language skills in ASL and English.

• Ability to pass background check. Background checks are \$42.00 and paid by the volunteer.

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills. Ability to communicate with both hearing and deaf audiences.
- Open-minded with a desire to work with the I/DD community.
- High level of patience.
- A flexible, and supportive approach toward working with teams.
- Ability to interpret in ASL for extended periods of time.
