### **Vaccine Clinic at Irby Ranch**

Sunflower Hill at Irby Ranch was thrilled to host a COVID-19 Vaccine Clinic in early April. Coordinated by the Alameda County Public Health Department, Satellite Affordable Housing Associates (SAHA), and Wellspring Pharmacy, the clinic was open to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities and their caregivers. We're thrilled to report that 300 people received their vaccination at the clinic! We were heartened to watch so many of our residents and their support staff receive their vaccine. There were many highlights from the day, including a man who walked into the clinic repeating "I'm not doing it, I'm not doing it, I'm not doing it." On his way out, he repeated "I did it, I did, I did it!" There was also a caregiver who commented, "We are so very grateful. We honestly didn't know how we were going to get this done. She won't keep her mask on, she can't wait in lines, she would scream because she is so stressed out by new environments. We couldn't imagine trying to get served at a

pharmacy or big vaccination site." It was a busy day, and we're thankful to the many volunteers who helped to make the clinic run smoothly.



While it's been a challenging year, we are grateful to all of you for your continuing support. Thank you for being a part of the Sunflower Hill community!
