Community Happenings

Report on Autism from The American Academy of Pediatrics

The American Academy of Pediatrics issued a <u>report</u> on December 16, 2019 with updated clinical recommendations for treating children with autism. These recommendations reflect the significant changes in

the field of autism since the last recommendations report in 2007. The organization recommended developmental and autism-specific screening at scheduled intervals throughout childhood and emphasized the importance of starting evidence-based intervention therapies early for more positive outcomes. Greta Thunberg Chosen as Time Magazine's Person of the Year

Environmental activist, Greta Thunberg has been chosen as the 2019 <u>Time Person of the Year</u> by Time Magazine. Thunberg, who is 16-years-old and has Asperger's Syndrome, has been vocal in her fight against climate change. In addition to being chosen as the 2019 Time Person of the Year, Thunberg also received an honorary fellowship from the <u>Royal Scottish Geographical Society</u> in 2019. This past September she addressed the UN Climate Action Summit in New York, and has been nominated for the 2019 <u>Nobel Peace Prize</u>.
