Dear Sunflower Hill Supporter,

On behalf of the Sunflower Hill Board of Directors and staff, we are thrilled to announce the planned development of our second Sunflower Hill residential community, which will be known as <u>Sunflower Hill at Lafayette Lane!</u>

On Monday, January 25, 2021, the Lafayette City Council approved the planned community, Lafayette Lane, which is being developed by <u>Pacific West Communities</u>, <u>Inc.</u>, <u>Miramar Capital</u>, and <u>Novin Development Corporation</u>. Sunflower Hill will collaborate with the developers and <u>Ward-Young Architects</u> to advise on the design of Building 1, which is currently planned as a 38-unit affordable rental community for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. Construction is anticipated to begin in 2023, with a tentative completion in 2026. Once complete, Sunflower Hill will provide person-centered activities for its residents and the greater community.

We are extremely grateful for the groundswell of support from the families in Lafayette who championed this cause, the Lafayette Planning Commission, and the Lafayette City Council, who unanimously approved the development.

At this time, we don't have specific details regarding the future leasing process. As soon as we have those details, we will share it with you via email, on our website, and on social media.

As we excitedly embark on our second residential community, we hope that you will join us by sharing this news with family and friends, both near and far.
