We had a blast on our recent field trip to the Alameda County Fairgrounds! From enjoying delicious fair food to



Dan and I feel incredibly blessed to be the parents of two kind, thoughtful, and genuinely fun sons. We love them with every piece of our hearts. Parenting our oldest, Andrew, hasn't always been easy—but it has been profoundly meaningful. As I've always said, Andrew has changed our lives and the lives of our friends and family, in the most beautiful ways. We are all better, more compassionate people because of the lessons he's taught us—lessons in patience, joy, resilience, and unconditional love.

We've celebrated everything, no matter how small it might seem to others: turning a D into a C, saying "hi" to a new friend, understanding a sarcastic joke, reading body language, learning how to compromise. The things most people take for granted, Andrew works hard to master—and when he does, we celebrate. We don't overlook the little things, because with Andrew, they are *big* things. And those victories have brought so much joy. I often

think—how lucky am I to receive these daily reminders of progress, persistence, and the purest kind of love?

Like so many parents of children with special needs, we used to lie awake wondering: *What will happen to Andrew when we're gone?* Then, a friend shared a vision to build a residential community for adults with I/DD. I felt the tug on my heart immediately and got involved.

Twelve years later, that dream has become a reality. For the past three years, Andrew has been living independently—with support—at Sunflower Hill. To say it's been life-changing feels like an understatement. Andrew thrives there. He loves having “his own pad,” just like his brother and peers. For Dan and me, it brings peace and joy knowing he’s safe, happy, and living a life with dignity and independence. And for his younger brother Robbie, it’s a gift—he doesn’t carry the pressure of having to someday be Andrew’s caregiver. Instead, they simply get to be brothers—each in their own homes, each writing their own story.

Our hearts are full of gratitude for the incredible gift that Sunflower Hill has brought to our family. It gave us not just a home for Andrew—but a future filled with hope, independence, and love.
