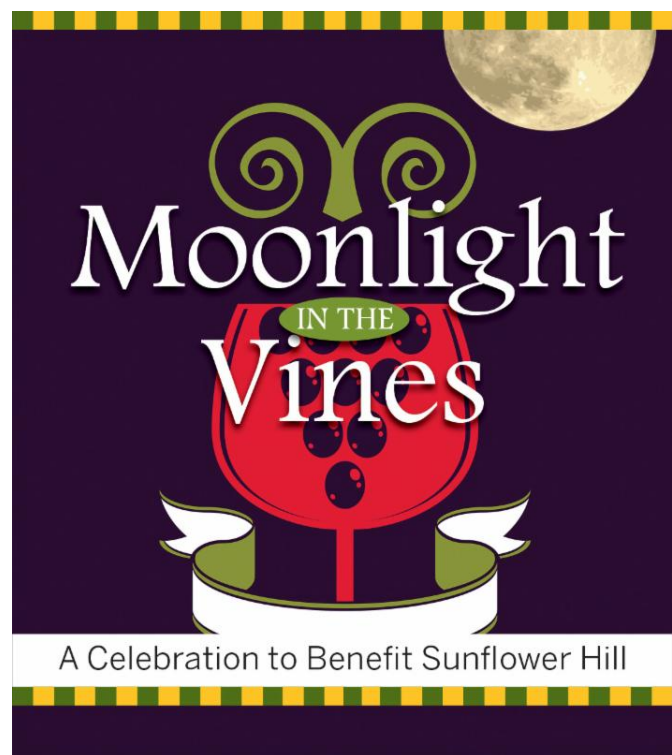
This year's Moonlight in the Vines will be on **Saturday, July 30, from 6-10 p.m.**

We're pleased to let you know that Sunflower Hill and MidPen Housing will be filing initial entitlement paperwork this month for our 45 residential community in Livermore! Our proposed affinity community is located on First Street - directly across from the Lowes/Safeway Shopping Center. Dahlin Architects has designed a beautiful mix of studio, one and two bedroom units, along with a design that affords a private master bedroom/master bath option with a common kitchen and living room area for several residents. Much of the design directly reflects suggestions made by Sunflower Hill families in the January and February focus groups. We are
