



## Rainbow Walk Activity Guide

### Materials Needed:

1. Rainbow Walk worksheet
2. Clipboard
3. Colored pencils, markers, or crayons
4. Tape

### Activity Instructions:

1. Find a place outside in your backyard, your neighborhood, or at a park where you can explore. Begin your search for all of the colors that you can find! Try looking for different colored flowers, or shades of the rainbow on leaves and stems of different plants. Sometimes if you look very closely, you will notice a lot of different colors on a single plant!
2. Once you've found a specific color, draw what you found in the corresponding box on the worksheet. Be sure to color it in! Can you find all of the colors on the worksheet? What color did you see the most? What color was the hardest to find?
3. **Bonus Round!** Make a rainbow bracelet by connecting a piece of tape, sticky side up, around your wrist. As you hunt for different colors, pick samples of each color that you find to attach to your bracelet.
