

## **Scavenger Hunt**

#### Fall Items!

#### **Materials Needed:**

- 1. Fall Items worksheet (on next page)
- 2. Clipboard
- 3. Writing utensil of your choice (pencil, pen, crayon) OR fun stickers
- 4. Optional: Plastic bag, reusable bag, or small basket to collect items

### **Activity Instructions:**

- 1. Find a place outside in your backyard, your neighborhood, or at a park where you can explore. Begin by reviewing the different Fall Items listed on your worksheet. As you walk, look all around you (up, down, side-to-side, under, over). What did you discover?
- 2. Once you've found an item on the worksheet, use your writing utensil or a sticker to mark the box. Optionally, if it doesn't belong to someone else, place it in your bag or basket to investigate further when you get home! Can you find all of the items on the worksheet?
- 3. Challenge Activities:
  - a. Keep track of how many of each item you find by using tally marks. What item did you see most?
  - b. Circle the item you found first and put a star next to the item you found last. Were you able to find them all?
  - c. If you collected items to take home for further investigation:
    - i. Make crayon rubbings to notice their unique textures.
    - ii. Use them like a paint brush to create a piece of art and to see what texture strokes they create.
    - iii. Glue them to a piece of paper or cardboard to create an abstract design or a figure.
    - iv. Look at each item under a microscope to investigate up close.
